## **COMPLAINING**

- 1. Complaining is the false way to handle a test from the Lord. It shows that the believer is not oriented to what God is trying to do for him at the time.
  - A. Complaining is forbidden, 1 Corinthians 10:10; Philippians 2:14.
- 2. All complaining is ultimately against God, Proverbs 19:3.
  - A. Neglect of doctrine causes the believer to complain against the Lord, Genesis 3:6-12.
  - B. Jeremiah 7:10 shows that a man with an non-humbled spirit always asks God why He didn't give him the grace to avoid a sin.
  - C. Isaiah 8:21-22, Revelation 16:9-11, the sinner blames God for judging him.
  - D. The Pharisee mocks God with his phony service and then complains that God would not bless it, Malachi 3:14; Isaiah 58:3.
- 3. Believers complain when God rejects his human good or human works done when he was carnal. Complaining often occurs when God rejects the believer's sinful production or human good. 2 Samuel 6:8
- 4. Complaining challenges the sovereignty of God, Romans 9:19-20.
- 5. The complainer challenges Christ in His teachings, Luke 5:30; 15:2; 19:7; John 6:41-43, 52.
- 6. Complaining against the communicators of God always brings divine discipline on the complainer, Exodus 17:3; Numbers 16:41; Isaiah 54:13-7.
- 7. Religious arrogance always complains about the liberty of the disciples of Christ. Galatians 5:1; Mark 7:2.
- 8. Man has no right to complain about anything God does, Lamentations 3:39.
- 9. Complaining tempts God to use judgment in discipline, Exodus 17:2.
- 10. Complaining provokes God, Numbers 14:2, 11; Deuteronomy 9:8, 22.

- 11. Believers are to cease from complaining and stay away from those who do complain, Isaiah 29:23-24.
- 12. Complaining is always a characteristic of the reversionist:
  - A. The Jews—Jude 16
  - B. Cain—Genesis 4:13-14.
  - C. The Jews—Exodus 14:11.
  - D. Aaron—Numbers 12.
  - E. Koran—Numbers 16.
  - F. The Pharisees—Luke 15:2.
- 13. Complainers are always punished, Numbers 11:1; 14:27-29; 16:45-46; Psalm 106:25-26.
- 14. It is wrong to complain over your wages, Matthew 20:11.
- 15. It is wrong to complain when your father shows someone grace who does not deserve it, Luke 15:29-30. (You want to see your brother get clobbered, but instead he is not disciplined as far as you know.)
- 16. Great heroes of the Bible also complained and lost out on blessing from God.
