TWELVE CHARACTERISTICS OF BELIEF (Faith-Trust)

- 1. Belief (with proper object, Lord Jesus Christ, Word of God) causes one to assemble and hear the Word of God as well as apply it, Hebrews 3:7-8.
- 2. Belief causes appreciation of the person and work of the Lord Jesus Christ, Hebrews 3:9.
- 3. Belief causes one to please the Lord WILLINGLY, Hebrews 3:10.
 - A. Public obedience as well as:
 - B. Private obedience, personal application to the whole counsel of the Word.
- 4. Belief makes you RELAXED, not RESTLESS, maturity oriented. Belief causes you to cease unbelieving activity, Hebrews 3:11.
- 5. Belief puts down unbelief, human good and evil, Hebrews 3:12.
- 6. Belief causes one to be honest (divine institutions), and have integrity (Bible doctrine), one does what is right and fair, Hebrews 3:13.
- 7. Belief gives us tremendous endurance, confidence, Hebrews 3:14.
- 8. Belief (faith) is characterized by an appreciative, thankful spirit in EVERYTHING, Hebrews 3:15.
- 9. Belief is found only in a MINORITY of believers, Hebrews 3:16.
- 10. Belief should be the way of life for believers, Hebrews 3:17.
- 11. Belief is characterized by being persuadable and teachable, Hebrews 3:18.
- 12. Belief ultimately could have taken the over 20 crowd through growth to maturity through the use of the promises. They could have really lived, Hebrews 3:19; Hebrews 4:1 ff.
